The Packing List

Bedroom

- Two sets of bed sheets
- Pacer Crossings: XL Twin
- Pacer Commons and Pacer Downs: Twin
- Mattress protector and pad (see sizes above)
- Pillows and blankets
- Bring extra pillowcases and blankets too!
- Bedspread/comforter (see sizes above)
- Clothes hangers
- Laundry detergent, fabric softener, etc.
- Laundry basket and/or bag
- Ironing board and iron
- Seasonal clothing, as well as a few items that will get you through an unexpected change in weather.
- Athletic clothes, shoes, or equipment

Bathroom

- Personal hygiene products
- If you can, bring multiples of items, especially toilet paper!
- Personal care items/shower items/toiletries
- Shower curtain, shower curtain rings, and bathmat
- Towels, hand towels, and washcloths
- Broom, dustpan, mop or Swiffer, vacuum
- Cleaning supplies such as Windex and paper towels. We love those shower cleaners you spray on every day!

Kitchen and Food

- Small microwave (Only for residents living in Pacer Downs or Commons) Pacer Crossings rooms include a microwave. Please check with your roommates -you only need one!
- Small coffee maker
- Dishes, cups, and utensils
- Pacer Downs and Pacer Commons residents: dishes/pots/pans needed for kitchen
- Pacer Crossings residents: microwave safe dishes for microfridge
- Dish soap, sponges, and brushes



Desk and Classroom

- Notepads, notebooks, binders, notebook paper, calendar, and planner
- School supplies (scissors, paper, paperclips, pens, highlighters, stapler, sticky notes, etc.)
- Backpack
- Desk lamp
- Wastebasket
- Graphing calculator
- Printer
- Laptop or tablet



Other

- Posters, pictures and any special personal item(s) that will help you feel at home
- Crates for storing books, clothes, etc.
- Alarm clock
- Back up cell phone charger
- TV, HDMI cord and cable cord
- TV can be a smart TV if you like, or you can bring a Firestick/Roku.
- Small electric fan
- Air freshener
- First aid supplies: Band aids, pain relievers, etc.
- UL listed surge protectors with breaker switch if you have a lot of stuff to plug in
- Any health insurance information (i.e. company name, policy number) in case you make an unexpected trip to the hospital/doctor
- Umbrella



Please do NOT bring

- Pets - except fish (10 gal. tank max)
- Dangerous items (fireworks, firearms, air guns, explosives, highly flammable substances, & no knives other than kitchen knives)
- Road/traffic signs
- Waterbeds
- Fire hazard items (halogen lamps, hot plates, toaster, toaster oven, fry-daddy)
- Neon signs
- Candles or incense
- Refrigerator
- Blue sticky putty to hang posters
